

HAZEL AND ALBERT BORSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Hazel and Albert Borson established this scholarship to continue and to promote their commitment to church and Lutheran higher education.

The Hazel and Albert Borson Scholarship shall be awarded annually to one student who:

- 1) Is attending college of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America at the time of application and at the time of the award,
- 2) Is a member of Hope Lutheran Church, Minneota, Minnesota,
- 3) Is a sophomore at the time of application,
- 4) Has a cumulative 3.0 or higher grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) at the time of application and at the time of the award.

Other factors to be considered in the selection are demonstrated leadership, volunteer activities in church or community and grade point average in past years.

The application deadline is April 1st with the funds disbursed the following January 15. The check will be made out to the student and the college or university she/he is attending and will be mailed directly to the college or university financial aid office.

In the event there is no eligible student in a given year, the award monies will be reinvested in the principal of the endowment fund.

This endowment is beginning in March 1992. The first applications were accepted May 1993 and the first scholarship was awarded January 1994.
