

THE ROBERT GEIWITZ SCHOLARSHIP

GENERAL

The Robert Geiwitz Scholarship was established in 1992, by Alan Geiwitz, in memory of his father. The interest from this fund is to be given to one or two deserving young persons from Hope Lutheran Church. The recipient(s) are to use the scholarship to further their education in a post-secondary institution.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Applicants must be member of Hope Lutheran Church, Minneota, Minnesota.
- 2) Applicants must be active in Hope Lutheran Church.
 - a. Faithful attendance at church and Sunday School
 - b. Demonstrate potential for future church leadership.

CRITERIA TO BE USED BY SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE IN DETERMINATION OF AWARD WINNER

- 1) Financial need
- 2) Active vs. partially active at Hope Lutheran
- 3) Demonstrate church leadership

OTHER INFORMATION

- 1) Application deadline is April 1st.
- 2) Notification of winner(s) will be made within 30 days from meeting of Scholarship Committee.
- 3) Scholarship money will be available and awarded to winner(s) after January 1. At that time, the recipient will be asked to submit a quarterly/semester statement from the school they are attending.
